Through collaborative discussions, studies. role-plays, and reflective activities, participants will deconstruct gender stereotypes, explore the influence of media and social pressure, and develop concrete actions to foster respectful, inclusive, and harassmentfree learning environments. The course concludes with tools for self-assessment. school-wide continued planning, and professional development.
